REGIONAL SPOTLIGHT

GRANITE BELT - QUEENSLAND

The Granite Belt is an exciting upcoming region located right on Brisbane's doorstep. It is home to award winning wineries, mouth-watering fruits, delectable cheeses, divine jams and warm-hearted people.

Due to the Granite Belt's high altitude, cool weather conditions and many micro-climates spread throughout the region, varieties that are suited to such conditions have proven to produce some exceptional quality fruit.

There are approximately 55 wineries in Queensland's Granite Belt region (although not all of them are open to the public) which cater to every palate. The spectrum ranges from sweet and cheerful to classic Burgundian style, to rarer varietals for thrill seekers wishing to venture off the path of familiarity. The latter are part of the "Strange Bird" association and include varietals such as Marsanne, Tempranillo, Durif and Petit Verdot just to name a few.

HERITAGE ESTATE

Bryce and Paddy Kassulke operate a very successful winery which has received many awards in recent years. The winery's name comes from the beautifully restored and maintained heritage listed building and was founded in 1992; the planting of 4 hectares was established in 1993.

For the first time in 13 years of the WINESTATE "Wine of the Year" competition, the winner was a white wine. Given that Australia is noted mainly for its reds, this in itself is unusual, but what makes it so wonderful is that it was a Queensland Chardonnay that took out this prestigious award - *Heritage Estate Reserve Granite Belt Chardonnay 2007*.

SYMPHONY HILL

Symphony Hill Wines is a family-owned boutique winery located in the cool climate Ballandean highlands of Queensland's Granite Belt. Ewen and Elissa Macpherson bought the old table grape and orchard property in 1996 after falling in love with the area and its potential for premium wine production. In partnership with Ewen's parents, Bob and Jill Macpherson, they have developed the vineyard to its present high standard. Symphony Hill Wines is a family focussed venture with, at one stage, four generations of the family living on the property. Ewen has completed his Bachelor of Applied Science in Viticulture while the Vineyard Manager and Head Winemaker, Mike Hayes, is a third-generation viticulturist in the Granite Belt region.

TOBIN

With the first vines planted in the early 1960's, the Tobin vineyard is said to have the oldest vinifera vines in the Granite Belt. Winemakers Adrian Tobin and David Gianni have a philosophy of minimal interference in the winemaking process, focussing instead on grape growing, and producing wines which showcase their terroir. Producing only 100-150 cases of each varietal, this is the epitome of a boutique winery.

P E N F O L D S C E L L A R L I S T

The history of Penfolds is inextricably linked to South Australia's colonial settlement and subsequent wine development for the state and the Australian wine industry.

Penfolds, first began in 1844 when Dr. Christopher Rawson Penfold and wife, Mary, purchased the Magill Estate at Mackgill, 8 kilometres east of Adelaide (now named Magill), for £1,2000, comprising of 500 acres. From here, Penfolds expanded into Australia's most popular winery and has become a major landholder, with vineyards and winery holdings through South Australia, New South Wales, and Victoria. The sheer diversity and quality of regional provenance, vineyard sites and independently grown fruit provides winemakers a rich array of colour, aroma and texture, a sequence of subsequent quality spectrums which allow a remarkable consistency of styles and quality across the Penfolds range.
