Sommeliers Selection Summer 2011 / 12 - 'A refreshing change'

With the warmer weather and festive season upon us, now's the time we crave refreshment and of course a little indulgence as well. This season I have decided not to limit my recommendations to wine alone, as I believe it is appropriate to provide a selection of drinks, not just wines, to be enjoyed for the right time or occasion.

With this in mind, I hope you take the time to indulge in one (or more) of these Summer time drinks. They are bound to refresh and are perfect to complement the lighter, brighter flavours of our Summer menu.

Sapore's Aperitivo 16.0

Our version of the 'Aperol Spritz', inspired by a memorable trip to northern Italy. Crushed navel and blood oranges combined with Aperol, Prosecco and soda. This is the ultimate summer drink, but be warned they are very addictive.

Rekorderlig Pear Cider (500ml) Vimmerby, Sweden 12.0

This delicious cider is produced from pure Swedish spring water and pears and has gained worldwide recognition over recent years. It is made in an off-dry style and is very moorish. For something different try it with our 'Gnocchi with 3 cheese sauce'.

Knappstein 'Reserve' Lager Clare Valley, SA 9.5

This Bavarian style lager is made by wine maker Tim Knappstein in the Clare Valley. Using only the finest ingredients this beer is best described as a wine-drinkers lager. It is complex and substantial with hop and citrus aroma's. Tropical fruit flavours lead to a crisp, lingering finish and just a hint of sweetness.

Tanqueray '10' Martini London, England 23.0

A classic cocktail given the deluxe treatment with the use of Tanqueray '10'. Batch distilled gin made using premium, hand-selected fruits and botanicals. We serve it stirred till ice cold, straight-up and finished with an orange twist.

Romate 'Marismeyo' Fino Sherry Jerez, Spain 9.0

Fino is a dry, aperitif style sherry. This is made by the famous Romate family of Jerez. Made from 100% Palamino grapes it has a bright pale golden colour and is light and dry on the palate with a lingering taste of almonds.

2010 Freeman Wines Rondinella Rosé Hilltops, NSW 9.0 / 36.0

Dr Brian Freeman produces this wine from 100% Rondinella grapes, the only plantings of this northern Italian varietal to be found in the whole of Australia. Inspired by the wines of this region, this rosé is savoury in style, with a vibrant pink and bronze colour. A perfect food wine with crisp acidity, medium weight and a spiced and lingering finish on the palate.

N.V.. Sorelle Bronca Prosecco Veneto, Italy 14.0 / 60.0

Produced in the home of Prosecco, the 'Valdobbiadene' sub-region of far north Italy, this sparkling wine is light and fresh in character. Distinct aroma's of green apple and pear's lead to a soft texture with flavours of orchard fruits. This a truly delicate and delicious wine to be savoured on a hot summer's day.

Simone's 'Fatto in Casa' Limoncello 8.0

Our version of this delicious Italian liqueur, hand-made to our secret recipe using only the finest, 100% natural ingredients. Served ice cold, the perfect end to a perfect meal.

Chablis

The famous wines of Chablis, some of which are listed below, are produced from 100% chardonnay. They are characterised by a flinty, chalky quality derived from the unique 'Kimmeridgean soil' they are grown on.

The 'Cru' classification centres around the location of the vineyard in Chablis. 'Premier Cru' and 'Grand Cru' sites are those that have the best soil, the best exposure to the sun and the right amount of nutrients. What the French call the best 'Terroir'. 'Bourgros' and 'Fourchame' below are fine examples of these vineyards. Petit Chablis and 'AC' wines are produced using fruit from across the region of Chablis. They still show the elegance and purity you expect from Chablis and are delicious. However they often lack the complexity and ageing potential of 'Premier Cru' and 'Grand Cru' wines.

Falanghina is a lesser known indigenous variety from the south of Italy. As with this wine, it is a medium bodied and pretty style with delicate aromas of cut flowers and stone fruits. There is a mild acidity, with the wine coating your mouth and leaving a soft almond aftertaste. I have to admit this wine is one of my favourite white wines on the list.
