## Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio

Classic Pinot Gris characters include honey and fresh butter balanced by a touch of tinned pears and dried apples. Pinot Grigio is often described as having smoky and salty mineral notes, pink grapefruit, melon and lemon, balanced by great acidity.

## Semillon

Bottle-aged Hunter Semillons exhibit a buttercup-yellow colour, burnt toast or honey characteristics on the nose and excellent complex flavours on the palate, with a long finish and soft acid. Young Hunter Valley semillon typically presents as a dry wine, boasting citrus flavours of lemon, lime or green apple.

Chenin Blanc provides a fairly neutral palate for the expression of terroir, vintage variation and the winemaker's treatment and technique. In cool areas the juice is sweet but high in acid with a full-bodied fruity palate.

# Red Wine

## Pinot Noir

The aroma of Pinot Noir is often one of the most complex of all varieties. With ripe grape or black cherry aromas, frequently accented by pronounced spiciness that suggests cinnamon, saffron or mint. Ripe tomato, mushroom and barnyard smells are common descriptors for identifying.

## Merlot & Merlot Blends

Merlot is a red grape that is used both as a blending grape and for varietal wines. Merlot based wines usually have medium body with hints of berry, plum and currant. Its softness and fleshiness, combined with early ripening, makes Merlot an ideal grape to blend with the late-ripening Cabernet Sauvignon.

## Grenache & Grenache Blends

Grenache is probably the most widely planted variety of red wine grape in the world. It is generally spicy with dark berry flavours. The aromas are powerful, including menthol, liquorice and black pepper. Because of its strong traits Grenache is usually blended with other grape varieties such as Shiraz and Mourvedre.

## Malbec

## Mataro

Mourvèdre, also known as Mataro, is grown in many regions around the world. Mourvèdre tends to produce tannic wines that can be high in alcohol with wild game and earthy notes, with soft red fruit flavors.

## Zinfandel

Zinfandel typically produces a robust red wine style. The taste of the wine depends on the ripeness of the grapes from which it is made. Red berry fruit flavors like raspberry predominate in wines from cooler areas, whereas blackberry, anise and pepper notes are more common in wines made in warmer areas.

# CAPE MENTELLE

## MARGARET RIVER

As one of Margaret River's 'founding five' wineries, Cape Mentelle pioneered many of the region's renowned wine styles and is today a benchmark for the quality of the regions wines. Established in 1970 by wine industry icon David Hohnen and his brothers Mark and Giles, Cape Mentelle vineyard has grown from a small planting of just 16 hectares to a vast 150 hectares under vine, winning the coveted Jimmy Watson Memorial Award for best one year old dry red in both 1983 and 1984.

### 2015 Cape Mentelle Sauvignon Blanc Semillon \$60



Delicate and lifted aromas of citrus blossom, lime, honeydew melon, blackcurrant and a hint of chalk dust. The palate is bright, elegant, well balanced with a creamy texture and a long finish; with pithy acidity and mineral character balanced by rich fruit flavours of lime, passionfruit and pink grapefruit.

### 2012 Cape Mentelle 'Wallcliffe' Sauvignon Blanc Semillon \$99



The aroma is a complex combination of ginger, lemongrass, lime, honeysuckle and subtle flinty characters. Tight and juicy with black currant and limes complimented by a complex textural pithy palate. The natural acidity is tight and precise providing an excellent backbone to the long, intense finish carrying flavours of lemon rind and subtle spices.

### 2014 Cape Mentelle Chardonnay \$95



Quince, apple and pear compote, cinnamon toast and roasted fig dominate the open, very expressive nose. The palate is full and rich with flavours reminiscent of bread crust, sticky fig pudding, candied nectarine and granny smith crisps. Notes of almond, pecan and creamy, savoury oak frame the long finish.

### 2014 Cape Mentelle 'Trinders' Cabernet Merlot \$70



A beautiful bouquet of perfumed violets and black currant, plum skin, cocoa and rosemary. Medium to full bodied with sweet ripe fruits of mulberry, plums and currants. The structure is fine with grapey soft tannins providing great length and intensity of flavour balanced by a subtle mix of roasted spices.

### 2012 Cape Mentelle 'Wilyabrup' Cabernet, Merlot, Cab Franc \$110



Dutch cocoa, aged tobacco, satsuma, plums and black currants with hints of violets and mint combine for an alluring nose. A deep flavoured and intense wine with abundant ripe plums, currants and liquorice balanced by touches of tobacco and chocolate. The tight gravelly tannins provide length and shape to the palate carrying the fruit flavours to provide a long and elegant finish.

### 2013 Cape Mentelle Cabernet Sauvignon \$185



The first notes on the nose are enticing and herbal, reminiscent of bay leaf and dry thyme. The nose then opens to intense ripe cassis, black pepper, smoke and cocoa with hints of fresh rolled tobacco leaves. The bright red attack explodes with red currants and fresh cassis, followed by touches of cloves and juniper berry. A graphite, mineral backbone leads to a still fresh finish supported by fine, structural and savoury tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon is one of the world's most widely recognised red grape varieties. When ripe, the colours and flavours packed into the thick skins can be remarkable. Each region imparting its own distinct characteristics

## Shiraz/Syrah & Shiraz Blends

In 1831, the Scotsman James Busby, often called “the Father of Australian viticulture”, made a trip back to Europe to collect cuttings from vines (primarily from France and Spain) for introduction to Australia. The cuttings were planted in the Sydney Botanical Gardens, and in Hunter Valley, and in 1839 brought from Sydney to South Australia.

# Dessert Wine

Semillon and Riesling produce most of Australia's 'sticky' wines. We offer a selection of Botrytis or Noble styles where the Botrytis fungus attacks the grapes and increases their sugar levels. These wines show complex characters of lemon, apricot and honey. Cordon or Cane Cut, are where the vine branches (cordons) are cut and the fruit is cut off from the nutrients of the rest of the vine increasing the sugars in the grape, often producing a lighter style than Noble rot wines.

# CAPE MENTELLE

## MARGARET RIVER

As one of Margaret River's 'founding five' wineries, Cape Mentelle pioneered many of the region's renowned wine styles and is today a benchmark for the quality of the regions wines. Established in 1970 by wine industry icon David Hohnen and his brothers Mark and Giles, Cape Mentelle vineyard has grown from a small planting of just 16 hectares to a vast 150 hectares under vine, winning the coveted Jimmy Watson Memorial Award for best one year old dry red in both 1983 and 1984.

### 2015 Cape Mentelle Sauvignon Blanc Semillon



Delicate and lifted aromas of citrus blossom, lime, honeydew melon, blackcurrant and a hint of chalk dust. The palate is bright, elegant, well balanced with a creamy texture and a long finish; with pithy acidity and mineral character balanced by rich fruit flavours of lime, passionfruit and pink grapefruit.

### 2012 Cape Mentelle 'Walcliffe' Sauvignon Blanc Semillon



The aroma is a complex combination of ginger, lemongrass, lime, honeysuckle and subtle flinty characters. Tight and juicy with black currant and limes complimented by a complex textural pithy palate. The natural acidity is tight and precise providing an excellent backbone to the long, intense finish carrying flavours of lemon rind and subtle spices.

### 2014 Cape Mentelle Chardonnay



Quince, apple and pear compote, cinnamon toast and roasted fig dominate the open, very expressive nose. The palate is full and rich with flavours reminiscent of bread crust, sticky fig pudding, candied nectarine and granny smith crisps. Notes of almond, pecan and creamy, savoury oak frame the long finish.

### 2013 Cape Mentelle 'Trinders' Cabernet Merlot



A beautiful bouquet of perfumed violets and black currant, plum skin, cocoa and rosemary. Medium to full bodied with sweet ripe fruits of mulberry, plums and currants. The structure is fine with grapey soft tannins providing great length and intensity of flavour balanced by a subtle mix of roasted spices.

### 2012 Cape Mentelle 'Wilyabrup' Cabernet, Merlot, Cabernet Franc



Dutch cocoa, aged tobacco, satsuma, plums and black currants with hints of violets and mint combine for an alluring nose. A deep flavoured and intense wine with abundant ripe plums, currants and liquorice balanced by touches of tobacco and chocolate. The tight gravelly tannins provide length and shape to the palate carrying the fruit flavours to provide a long and elegant finish.

### 2013 Cape Mentelle Cabernet Sauvignon



The first notes on the nose are enticing and herbal, reminiscent of bay leaf and dry thyme. The nose then opens to intense ripe cassis, black pepper, smoke and cocoa with hints of fresh rolled tobacco leaves. The bright red attack explodes with red currants and fresh cassis, followed by touches of cloves and juniper berry. A graphite, mineral backbone leads to a still fresh finish supported by fine, structural and savoury tannins.
